IN APPRECIATION FOR THE CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY
DIANNE FEINSTEIN AS A MEMBER OF THE
SENATE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

WHEREAS, The Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District wishes to acknowledge United States Senator Dianne Feinstein for her forty-six years of public service to her constituents of the State of California and show appreciation for such service that includes service to the rural communities of Phelan and Piñon Hills; and

WHEREAS, Senator Dianne Feinstein started her public service in 1969 as an elected member of the San Francisco County Board of Supervisors and served two and one-half terms as the President of the Board; and

WHEREAS, in November 1978 Senator Dianne Feinstein became the Mayor of the City of San Francisco following the assassination of Mayor George Moscone and Supervisor Harvey Milk; and

WHEREAS, in 1987, Senator Dianne Feinstein was named the nation's Most Effective Mayor; and

WHEREAS, Senator Dianne Feinstein has served California as a United States Senator for more than 20 years and is the first woman to serve California in that role; and

WHEREAS, Senator Dianne Feinstein has shown a true appreciation of preserving natural resources throughout the state, including within San Bernardino County and the Mojave Reserve; and

WHEREAS, in the 111th Congress, Senator Dianne Feinstein became the first woman senator to assume the Chairmanship of the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, overseeing the nation's 16 intelligence agencies; and

WHEREAS, Senator Dianne Feinstein is a member of the Senate Judiciary Committee, the Senate Appropriations Committee, the Senate Rules and Administration Committee, and serves as the Chair of the Subcommittee on Energy and Water; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, Senator Dianne Feinstein became the first woman to become the Chairperson of the joint Congressional Committee on Inaugural Ceremonies.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District does hereby **RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER** as follows:

Section 1. That this Board of Directors does hereby acknowledge and express appreciation for Senator Dianne Feinstein's invaluable service and striving to improve the lifestyle of the nation, preserving natural resources, improving urban and rural living, and working as a champion for California.
