Grand re-opening and ribbon cutting ceremony for Phelan Park to be held at 11:00 a.m. on April 26, 2014 at Phelan Park located at 4176 Warbler Rd. Phelan, CA 92371.

On April 26, 2014, the Board of the Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District (District) will hold a grand re-opening of Phelan Park in conjunction with Community Services Awareness Day. The ribbon cutting ceremony will begin at 11:00 a.m. The main park was built in July 2004. Enhancements, including installation of 10,000 square feet of grass, installation of a new concrete patio/picnic shelter, installation of a display garden, and re-painting of the basketball court, were completed at the end of 2013. Currently, the park is home to the Phelan Farmers Market held every Monday from 2pm-6pm.
