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Ribbon cutting ceremony for Piñon Hills Park to be held at 10 a.m. on April 9, 2014 at the Piñon Hills Park located at 10433 Mountain Rd. Piñon Hills, CA 92372.

On April 9, 2014, the Board of the Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District (District) will hold a ribbon cutting ceremony for the Piñon Hills Park enhancements. Enhancements include the installation of a basketball court, additional swings, a fitness track/walking trail, and landscaping. Those invited to the ceremony include the Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services Board of Directors, the Phelan Chamber of Commerce, the Piñon Hills Chamber of Commerce, former County Supervisor Brad Mitzelfelt, County Supervisor Robert Lovingood, Field Representative for the County Supervisor Ron Frame, Assemblyman Steve Fox, State Senator Steve Knight, Association of San Bernardino County Special Districts members, Sergeant Mellow, Captain Kittleman, Chief Campos, the Snowline School District Board of Directors, Superintendent of the Snowline School District, and former Directors of the Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District.

In March 2008, when the District separated from San Bernardino County, a plan was in place to expand the Piñon Hills Park. The plan needed to be updated to meet County building standards. The project's design work was awarded to and completed by Steeno Design and TRLS Engineering. Design work began in March 2013 and was submitted to the San Bernardino County Planning Department in July 2013. The Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services Board of Directors awarded the construction contract to Aghapy Group, Inc. The project broke ground January 21, 2014 and was completed in February 2014. The project was funded by a \$30,000 donation from former County Supervisor Brad Mitzelfelt's discretionary fund to help pay for the County fees. The majority of the project was funded by a Proposition 40 grant from San Bernardino County.
